

Bar Gun trim-ring for countertop



Drilling a hole in your countertop to allow your bargun to come through leaves a rough edge. There are many ways to make it look nicer. One way is to use Watts Part # 5-5-3H --Pop-up Basin Drain. It is the same part one would use for a bathroom sink drain, but needs to be modified for this application.

Only the Pop-up housing on the left is needed, you can throw all other parts away.



Using a saw, cut the Pop-up assembly in half, right below the Jam-nut threads.

Use a round or curved file to remove all burrs from cutting, leaving the inside edges smooth.



Drill a 1 3/4 inch hole in the countertop. If you can only drill a 1 1/2 inch hole, it is possible to make it fit, however you will need to taper the edges of the hole to allow the top of the Pop-up assembly "sink" into the countertop. Remove either the Jam-nut or top ring to install in a counter. In cases where the counter is too thin to tighten Jam-nut, a length of 1 1/2 inch PVC pipe can be cut and used as a spacer.
